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Message from the President

Dear Colleagues,



We are pleased to provide the fourth report in the series of our statistical profile reports on the 2018 PA profession data. The Statistical Profile of Certified Physician Assistants by State, now in its fifth year, includes an exciting new feature. In collaboration with the Federation of State Medical Boards (FSMB), this report also includes the number of PAs licensed in each state jurisdiction. According to the FSMB's data, there are a total of 158,438 current PA licensees in the U.S.

The NCCPA data is presented by state of residence, and the FSMB data that has been added to the header for each state reflects the number of current PA licenses issued in the state, recognizing that an individual PA may hold a license in more than one jurisdiction and that a PA may live in one state but practice in a neighboring state(s). We would like to officially recognize and express our appreciation to the FSMB for providing this added data that helps to enrich the utility of this report.

This report continues to demonstrate the growth of the PA profession and the impact PAs have on healthcare throughout the U.S. In 2018, the number of Certified PAs in the United States and the District of Columbia increased by 6.6%, with almost every state seeing an increase and the largest increases occurring in Rhode Island (13.7%), Arkansas (11.4%), and Nevada (11.3%). This growth is especially important as the Association of American Medical Colleges recently reaffirmed its projections of physician shortages through 2032.¹ In four states that have more rural populations, close to half of the PAs are working in primary care specialties. However, PAs are also helping to meet the needs of physician shortages in other areas such as surgery, emergency medicine, and a wide variety of other practice areas. Just over 40% of PAs in the U.S. are working in a hospital setting.

As always, we are grateful to the dedicated Certified PAs who update and maintain their profiles. Without their support and contributions to the most comprehensive and accurate source of PA data nationwide, reports such as this would not be possible. Thank you for all that you do on behalf of the PA profession!

About the Data and Collection Methodology

Introduction

Since certifying the first physician assistants (PAs) in 1975, NCCPA has collected data on the PA profession as PAs completed various processes related to obtaining initial certification and then maintaining certification by earning and logging continuing medical education credits and passing recertification examinations. In May 2012, NCCPA's data gathering efforts were significantly enhanced with the launch of the PA Professional Profile. This data gathering instrument is presented to PAs through a secure portal within NCCPA's website. The Profile was launched with two modules: "About Me" and "My Practice."

In December 2012, NCCPA added a "Recently Certified" module delivered online to PAs who have been certified for less than six months. Data from that module can be found in another report (*2018 Statistical Profile of Recently Certified Physician Assistants*) and which is updated annually.

Data Editing and Analysis

Data reflected in this report includes responses from PAs who were certified as of December 31, 2018 and have made updates to their profile between January 1, 2016 and December 31, 2018. In addition, some data were obtained from other NCCPA data collection strategies. As of December 31, 2018, there were 131,152 certified PAs, and 117,280 provided responses for at least a portion of the PA Professional Profile, yielding an overall response rate of 89.4%.

The data provided in this report has been aggregated from the individual response data provided by PAs through the PA Professional Profile or other NCCPA data gathering efforts. Responses were examined for consistency and potential errors. In cases of obvious error or inconclusive data, the responses were not included in the analysis. The number of responses to individual items varies due to differing response rates or due to the data being removed for reasons previously noted. Number of Licensed PAs is derived from 2018 *Federation of State Medical Boards* licensure data. Analyses of the data in this report consist primarily of descriptive statistics.

About NCCPA

NCCPA is the only certifying organization for PAs in the United States. Established as a not-for-profit organization in 1974, NCCPA is dedicated to providing certification programs that reflect standards for clinical knowledge, clinical reasoning and other medical skills and professional behaviors required upon entry into practice and throughout the careers of PAs. All U.S. states, the District of Columbia and the U.S. territories have decided to rely on NCCPA certification as one of the criteria for licensure or regulation of PAs. More than 160,000 physician assistants have been certified by NCCPA since 1975.

Figure 1: Top Practice Areas of Certified PAs





Figure 2: Top Practice Settings of Certified PAs



Figure 4: Top Practice Areas of Certified PAs





Figure 5: Top Practice Settings of Certified PAs



Figure 7: Top Practice Areas of Certified PAs





Figure 8: Top Practice Settings of Certified PAs



Figure 10: Top Practice Areas of Certified PAs





Figure 11: Top Practice Settings of Certified PAs



Figure 13: Top Practice Areas of Certified PAs





Figure 14: Top Practice Settings of Certified PAs



Figure 16: Top Practice Areas of Certified PAs





Figure 17: Top Practice Settings of Certified PAs



Figure 19: Top Practice Areas of Certified PAs





Figure 20: Top Practice Settings of Certified PAs



Figure 22: Top Practice Areas of Certified PAs





Figure 23: Top Practice Settings of Certified PAs



Figure 25: Top Practice Areas of Certified PAs





Figure 26: Top Practice Settings of Certified PAs



Figure 28: Top Practice Areas of Certified PAs





Figure 29: Top Practice Settings of Certified PAs



Figure 31: Top Practice Areas of Certified PAs





Figure 32: Top Practice Settings of Certified PAs



Figure 34: Top Practice Areas of Certified PAs





Figure 35: Top Practice Settings of Certified PAs



Figure 37: Top Practice Areas of Certified PAs





Figure 38: Top Practice Settings of Certified PAs



Figure 40: Top Practice Areas of Certified PAs





Figure 41: Top Practice Settings of Certified PAs



Figure 43: Top Practice Areas of Certified PAs





Figure 44: Top Practice Settings of Certified PAs



Figure 46: Top Practice Areas of Certified PAs





Figure 47: Top Practice Settings of Certified PAs



Figure 49: Top Practice Areas of Certified PAs





Figure 50: Top Practice Settings of Certified PAs



Figure 52: Top Practice Areas of Certified PAs





Figure 53: Top Practice Settings of Certified PAs



Figure 55: Top Practice Areas of Certified PAs





Figure 56: Top Practice Settings of Certified PAs



Figure 58: Top Practice Areas of Certified PAs





Figure 59: Top Practice Settings of Certified PAs



Figure 61: Top Practice Areas of Certified PAs





Figure 62: Top Practice Settings of Certified PAs



Figure 64: Top Practice Areas of Certified PAs





Figure 65: Top Practice Settings of Certified PAs



Figure 67: Top Practice Areas of Certified PAs





Figure 68: Top Practice Settings of Certified PAs



Figure 70: Top Practice Areas of Certified PAs





Figure 71: Top Practice Settings of Certified PAs



Figure 73: Top Practice Areas of Certified PAs





Figure 74: Top Practice Settings of Certified PAs



Figure 76: Top Practice Areas of Certified PAs





Figure 77: Top Practice Settings of Certified PAs



Figure 79: Top Practice Areas of Certified PAs





Figure 80: Top Practice Settings of Certified PAs



Figure 82: Top Practice Areas of Certified PAs





Figure 83: Top Practice Settings of Certified PAs



Figure 85: Top Practice Areas of Certified PAs





Figure 86: Top Practice Settings of Certified PAs



Figure 88: Top Practice Areas of Certified PAs





Figure 89: Top Practice Settings of Certified PAs



Figure 91: Top Practice Areas of Certified PAs





Figure 92: Top Practice Settings of Certified PAs



Figure 94: Top Practice Areas of Certified PAs





Figure 95: Top Practice Settings of Certified PAs



Figure 97: Top Practice Areas of Certified PAs





Figure 98: Top Practice Settings of Certified PAs



Figure 100: Top Practice Areas of Certified PAs





Figure 101: Top Practice Settings of Certified PAs



Figure 103: Top Practice Areas of Certified PAs





Figure 104: Top Practice Settings of Certified PAs



Figure 106: Top Practice Areas of Certified PAs





Figure 107: Top Practice Settings of Certified PAs



Figure 109: Top Practice Areas of Certified PAs





Figure 110: Top Practice Settings of Certified PAs



Figure 112: Top Practice Areas of Certified PAs





Figure 113: Top Practice Settings of Certified PAs



Figure 115: Top Practice Areas of Certified PAs





Figure 116: Top Practice Settings of Certified PAs



Figure 118: Top Practice Areas of Certified PAs





Figure 119: Top Practice Settings of Certified PAs



Figure 121: Top Practice Areas of Certified PAs





Figure 122: Top Practice Settings of Certified PAs



Figure 124: Top Practice Areas of Certified PAs





Figure 125: Top Practice Settings of Certified PAs



Figure 127: Top Practice Areas of Certified PAs





Figure 128: Top Practice Settings of Certified PAs



Figure 130: Top Practice Areas of Certified PAs





Figure 131: Top Practice Settings of Certified PAs



Figure 133: Top Practice Areas of Certified PAs





Figure 134: Top Practice Settings of Certified PAs



Figure 136: Top Practice Areas of Certified PAs





Figure 137: Top Practice Settings of Certified PAs



Figure 139: Top Practice Areas of Certified PAs





Figure 140: Top Practice Settings of Certified PAs







Figure 145: Top Practice Areas of Certified PAs





Figure 146: Top Practice Settings of Certified PAs



Figure 148: Top Practice Areas of Certified PAs





Figure 149: Top Practice Settings of Certified PAs



Figure 151: Top Practice Areas of Certified PAs





Figure 152: Top Practice Settings of Certified PAs



Figure 154: Top Practice Areas of Certified PAs





Figure 155: Top Practice Settings of Certified PAs


